



Message from Far Post on September 12, 2011

This is a reminder that Far Post has its paperwork and uniform nights coming up in a few weeks. Far Post is organizing the paperwork details a little differently than last year. If you do not need help filling out forms or taking care of uniform sizing, then there is no need for you to attend one of these nights. If you feel the need for help and guidance or you are new to Far Post, we recommend that you come to one of these nights. The whole process takes around 30 minutes, depending on the traffic flow. We want to make this whole process as easy and time efficient as possible for all families. It is critical that all paperwork is handed into Far Post by the deadline (Thursday, September 29th).

If you need to attend one of these nights, you can come on Tuesday, September 27th or Thursday, September 29th from 6:00-9:00pm at Far Post at the Champlain Valley Exposition in Essex Junction. The event will be held in main entryway to The Soccer Center. The player and one parent must attend one of these sessions. We must have all paperwork handed in by Thursday, September 29th.

Uniforms – We are continuing with the uniform kits that we had last year. If you have a uniform that fits, then there is no need to order a new one. But please know that players will need their kits to fit throughout the season, so what fits now may not fit in May and June, so plan accordingly. We will be handling uniform ordering differently this year. Thanks to Jacky McCue, we have been able to set up an online ordering system through Eurosport. Now, you will go directly online to order any items of the uniform along with some selective spirit gear. We have set up this system to make the whole process faster, easier and less expensive for you. Once you place your order, you will pay Eurosport directly and receive your items directly at your home. The system is quite easy, and we think you will be happy with this new development. As an added benefit, you may do this on your own time and at any point during the season.

At this time, we are in the process of finalizing the online Far Post Store for families. Once a team's roster has been downloaded into the Store, each team will receive an email from either their Team Manager informing you that the online store is now available for your ordering. The club will have a link on the homepage of the website for all families to use. It is VERY important to understand that ANY and ALL items that are customized are NON-REFUNDABLE. That means jerseys, shorts and any items with names & numbers cannot be returned unless it is due to an error in the embroidery. So, please make sure you get the sizing correct the first time. Bigger is always better but too small may cause you to incur an additional cost.

What to remember if attending one the registration nights:

- Copies of all of the waiver forms attached
- Copy of birth certificate (For new players ONLY)
- Checkbook or credit card – We only accept Visa and MasterCard
- Your medical insurance information (insurance company, insured name and policy number)
- Doctors name, address and phone number
- Date of player's last tetanus shot
